The 1989 NASAP Convention, "Cooperation Takes Courage" was a well-run, informative opportunity for professional development, relaxation, and meetings with others. More than 360 attended from across the North American continent.

Numbers for the four day convention included 128 registrants in pre-convention workshops, 80 presentations, and 125 registrants for post-convention workshops.

The 1989 Continental Social Interest Award was given posthumously to Nick Ionedes, and was accepted by his widow Angie and daughter Stephanie at the Friday evening banquet. It was an emotional and important tribute.

NASAP Distinguished Service Awards were given to Hal McAbee, Cam Meredith, Mim Pew, and Homer Kiracofe for their work within NASAP and their communities.

I want to thank our hosts, the Alfred Adler Institute of Minnesota. The Convention Co-Coordinators, Mary McGuire and Jill Marks, were superb in bringing their volunteers into the group spirit which made the convention possible. It should also be noted that our professional convention coordinator, Linda Wise, handled the logistics and made certain the events ran smoothly.

We thank the more than 100 presenters of workshops and programs who volunteered their expertise and made this information available to convention participants. I think we often fail to realize the amount of preparation and effort which goes into each workshop and program. Without the presenters, it would not have been possible.
